2nd committee meeting

Members present were Chairman Scott Crosby, Committee members Taft Matney and Larry Goodson. Chief Bill Stewart was present. Interim City Administrator Bryan Turner was also present.

1. Call to order.- Chairman Crosby
2. Public comment.- None
3. Reading and approval of minutes. –May 7, 2018
Councilman Matney made a motion to approve the minutes with Chairman Crosby seconding. Councilman Goodson was not present at the May meeting and did not vote. The vote was unanimous (2-0).
4. Reports or communications from city officers.
The HazMat line of the fire department shows 383% over budget. BASF and Colonial Pipeline donated money for the purchase of air monitors and that is where the expense will come from. The department received all new air packs. Personnel are training on them. The new pickup was received from Vic Bailey Ford today.

Chief Turner said the police budget looks good. There are a few expenditures remaining.
5. Old business- None
6. New business
 - a. Agreement with Greenville Health System/ Greenville EMS
Chief Stewart reported that Greenville County was awarded a grant of \$2 million dollars from Greenville Health System to Greenville EMS for first responders and EMT training. The goal is to increase the number of EMTs across the county. Our department is licensed through DHEC. We have access to the grant money to pay for Basic EMT training. Mauldin is 3rd tier in

the grant to get additional equipment. This agreement will allow us to access the grant money for Basic EMT training.

Councilman Matney made a motion to send this to full council with a recommendation of approval. Councilman Goodson seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous (3-0).

7. Public comment.

Councilman Merritt asked about what Alpha to Delta to Echo was. Chief Stewart said that is a dispatch ranking. Echo is more extreme emergencies. Alpha is a lower response. Delta and Echo calls are things like cardiac arrests. The department is usually not dispatched to Alpha calls unless needed.
