SUBJECT: Repaving Asphalt Parking Lot at City Park

REQUEST

The Recreation Committee is requested to recommend awarding the bid for repaving the asphalt parking lot at City Park to Panagakos for full City Council's consideration.

HISTORY/BACKGROUND

City Council appropriated funding in its FY2021 budget for repaving the asphalt parking lot at City Park.

ANALYSIS / STAFF FINDINGS

A Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued for repaving the asphalt parking lot at City Park on September 28, 2020 and closed on October 28, 2020. The City received proposals from 2 firms. All of the proposals were reviewed by an Evaluation Committee and based on the ranking of the proposals, Panagakos was recommended as the lowest most responsive bidder.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Council appropriated \$159K in its FY2021 budget. The recommended bid is \$166,217. Funding is available for this project in the FY2021 Capital Projects Fund.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends awarding the bid for repaving the asphalt parking lot at City Park to Panagakos.
