3. Reading and Approval of Minutes

a. Public Safety Committee Meeting: September 6, 2022

a. Fire Chief Brian McHone

i. Budget Review- All line items are on track except for 422-170. This was because of an accident with one of our fire trucks. We paid for repairs but then were reimbursed by the insurance company.

The contractor for fire headquarters is about a week behind. The roof trusses came in today.

b. Clerk of Court Donna Derado

i. Budget Review- The department is current with the State Treasurer's Office.

c. Police Chief George Miller

i. Budget Review- Lt. Hodrea reported the budget looks good. The vehicle maintenance line is a little over due to an accident, but the insurance company has reimbursed the City.

Lt. Hodrea said are two more Citizens' Academy sessions left. Officer Madden is conducting active shooter training for City employees and at City businesses.

Officer Madden participated in several Trunk or Treats over Halloween.

6. New Business

a. Amended agreement with the County Drug Enforcement Unit

We have an agreement with the County DEU. This item is an amendment to the agreement to allow for a DEU Commander from the Sheriff's Office and a salary portion. The Commander will report to the DEU governing board.

b. Duke Energy Utility Easement

The Easement will authorize Duke Energy to access, install, maintain and inspect the proposed electrical facilities on the new fire headquarters property.

c. Grant Acceptance

The police department was notified 11/4/2022 of the grant award for in-car cameras. The grant was awarded through the SC Department of Public Safety in the amount of \$86,542.64.

Vote: The vote was unanimous (3-0).
