FREE MEMBERSHIP

- All full-time employees of the City of Mauldin
- All **actively serving** City officials and appointed members of City Boards/Commissions
- Active-duty military service member (with valid ID)

50% MEMBERSHIP DISCOUNT

- Part-time employees of the City of Mauldin
- Family members of **actively serving** full-time and part-time employees of the City of Mauldin
- Retired military and veterans and their families
- National Guard, State Guard and Reserve Military

ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES/ELECTED OFFICIALS 50% DISCOUNT

- Retired employees of 20 years **or more** of creditable service to the City of Mauldin
- Former Elected officials of 20 years **or more** of creditable service to the City of Mauldin

Motion: Councilman Matney made a motion to send this item with the changes to Council. Chairman Allgood seconded the motion.

Vote: The vote was unanimous (2-0).
