In the next 30 days power will be run to the building, HVAC started, interior lighting will be installed, painting is continuing, cabinets will be installed, plumbing will be done, gutters installed, and the bays prepped. The Station should be completed by the end of the third quarter.

SUBJECT: Transfer of Equipment to Travelers Rest Police Department

REQUEST

To approve the transfer of 10 I.D. scanners to the Traveler's Rest Police Department

HISTORY/BACKGROUND

MPD patrol units use scanners to scan identification cards out in the field. MPD has an abundance of scanners that are end of life and have been replaced.

ANALYSIS or STAFF FINDINGS

We have an abundance of spare scanners that are at the end of life and have been replaced with new scanners. We would typically use them as spares or destroy the ones that are not usable, but in talking with Travelers Rest Police Dept., they are in need of 10 scanners. I think it would better benefit the comradery of local agencies by donating them to an agency within our county that is in need of them.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Fiscal Impact would minimal if any.

RECOMMENDATION

The recommendation is that we transfer 10 of the spare scanners to the Travelers Rest Police Department to assist them with their patrol functions.

SUBJECT: Donation of outdated turn out gear

REQUEST

Staff is requesting that our outdated turnout gear be donated to Ukraine or the Dominican Republic by way of a non-profit group based in Spartanburg.

HISTORY/BACKGROUND

NFPA standards for fire apparatus and gear specify service lifecycles, gear must be retired from service 10 years after the date of manufacture. Mauldin Fire department would like to donate our outdated turnout gear to help under-resourced fire departments in poor and developing countries.

ANALYSIS or STAFF FINDINGS

FISCAL IMPACT

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends donating expired turnout gear to fire departments in poor and developing countries.
