FOOD TRUCK GUIDE

WHERE CAN I SET UP?

Food trucks, including trailers and carts, are only allowed to set up in the City of Mauldin at lawful events at the invitation of the event organizer. This includes events at the Mauldin Cultural Center and other City venues, Bridgeway Station, schools, churches, neighborhoods, and businesses such as grand opening events and employee appreciation events.

WHAT PERMITS OR LICENSES DO I NEED FROM THE CITY?

Any food truck, including trailers and carts, that set up in the City of Mauldin must first have a Mauldin Business License. In order to obtain a Mauldin Business License you will need to provide the following:

- A completed business license application,
- A copy of your DHEC permit,
- A copy of your driver's license, and
- A copy of the registration and insurance for the food truck

After your application has been approved by the City, your food truck will need to be inspected by the Mauldin Fire Department before you can receive your Mauldin Business License.

WHAT RULES DO I NEED TO FOLLOW?

Food trucks, including trailers and carts, must be set back at least 15 feet from any fire hydrant, utility box or vault, handicap accessible ramp or aisle, and building entrance or exit.

Food trucks cannot be parked in areas that would impair the visibility of any motorist, cyclist, or pedestrian—especially at driveway entrances, crosswalks, and intersections.

Adequate trash collection and disposal must be provided. DO NOT discharge any fat, oil, grease, or wastewater into any sanitary sewer lines or stormwater drains.

CAN I SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES?

The sale of alcoholic beverages at an event is only allowed if it has been permitted at that location by the South Carolina Department of Revenue Alcohol Beverage Licensing and has been approved by the Mauldin Police Chief.
