



## Mauldin GateWay Bridge Protest Permit Application

The City of Mauldin GateWay Bridge may be used for organized protests or demonstrations subject to City approval and subject to the regulations contained in Article V, Chapter 28 of the Mauldin Code of Ordinances. An application must be submitted to the City Clerk, Cindy Miller, **(10) business days** prior to the planned protest or demonstration. The purpose of the application is to maintain a point of contact for planned events utilizing the bridge and scheduling of events.

Submission of this application does not constitute approval. Written authorization from the City of Mauldin is required prior to the event. To submit online, email this form to [cmiller@mauldincitysc.com](mailto:cmiller@mauldincitysc.com) or deliver to Mauldin City Hall, City Clerk's Office.

**No banners, signage, or materials of any kind may be attached to, affixed to, hung from, or otherwise secured to the GateWay Bridge or any City infrastructure. Signs must comply with Section 6:4 Signs of the Mauldin Zoning Ordinance and cannot exceed four (4) square feet in sign face area and four (4) feet in height.** Participants may not impede vehicular traffic, emergency access, or pedestrian movement, and all participants must comply with applicable laws and lawful directions from City officials.

*If a permit is denied, the City Administrator will provide a written explanation of the denial and where possible, offer an alternative time, place or manner for the demonstration that would be approved. The applicant has the right to appeal the decision of the City Administrator within five (5) business days. The appeal does not stay the denial of the permit and a hearing will be held within thirty (30) days from the date of notice with Mauldin City Council.*

*A permit is not required for a spontaneous gathering of individuals responding to recent news or events, so long as the gathering does not violate any other provision of municipal code.*

**NOTE: All roads, sidewalks, and parking lots at BridgeWay Station are private property and are intended to be used by tenants, their customers, employees and invitees. Violators may be charged with trespassing.**
